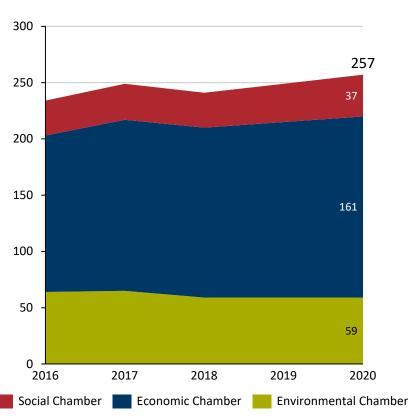
Actively seeking opps (4)

- The European Region is the "engine" for driving FSC's global success and growth
- Work increasing moves towards market-based activities
 (Demand & Supply) & away from technical-based activities
- FSC's <u>position</u> in Europe remains Strong but is being challenged in different ways to provide more "value" to different stakeholder groups
- <u>Europe's forests</u> are "growing but the quality is degrading and there are ambitions for restoring natural habitats and nature"
- Poor diversity in <u>membership</u> with strong & vocal econ chamber (Int and Nat) members
 - <u>Dedicated staff</u> (mainly working in INP's), many who are well established in FSC, with strong and diverse views

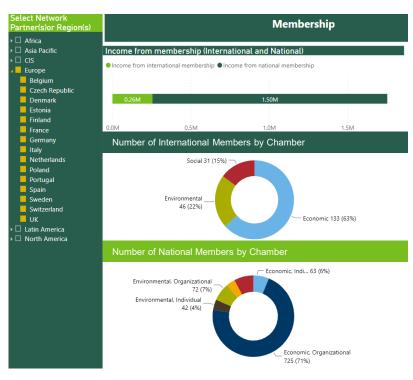
Membership Details

Relevance International & National members Only NP Countries



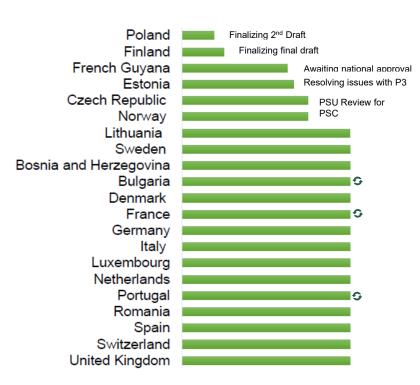
European Countries INT/Nat members Split in 2020

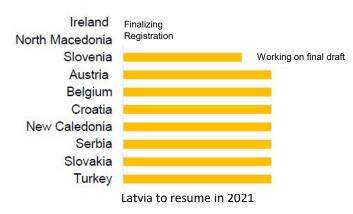
Key Messages

- More than 2/3 of the core region is well covered by NFSS Normative Framework
- Some more significant countries (PL, Fin) are still working on transition to V5.2- next year "make or break"?
- Some countries will start a review/ revision of P&Cv5.2 already in 2021- makes "overcoming differences/ harmonization" challenging from timing perspective

- INS provides a useful and focused way to engage in some countries, e.g. Slovakia commitment 100% FSC by 2024

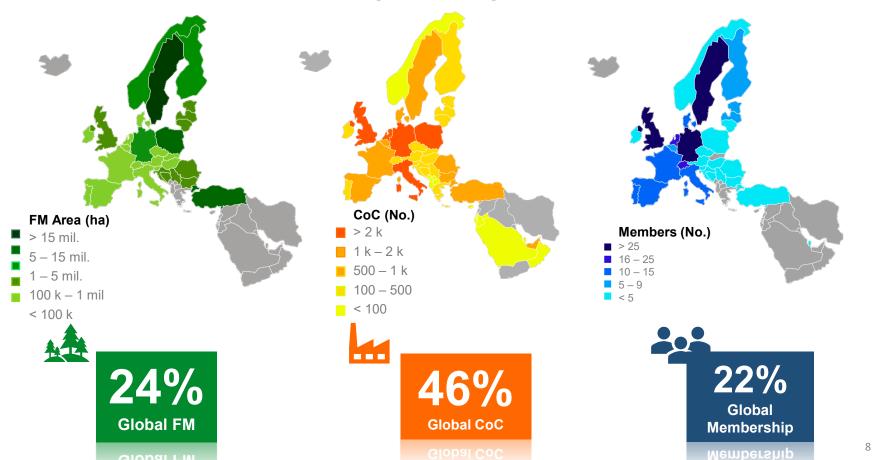

Potential currently based primarily on production forest

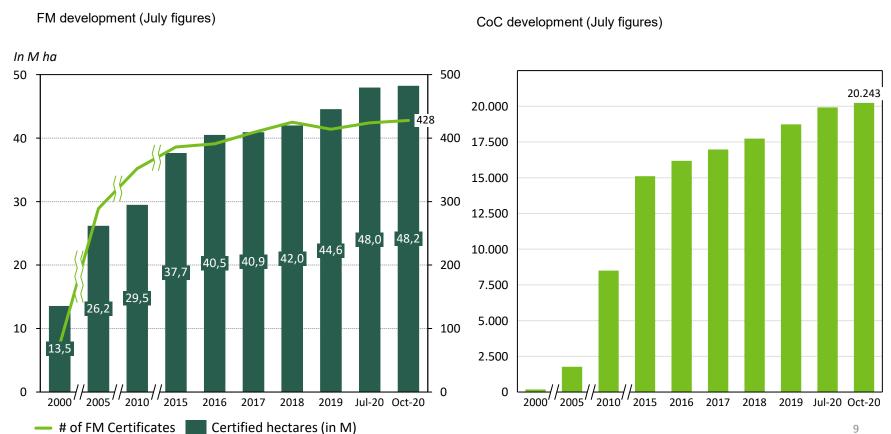
Certificate & Membership by Country, 2020

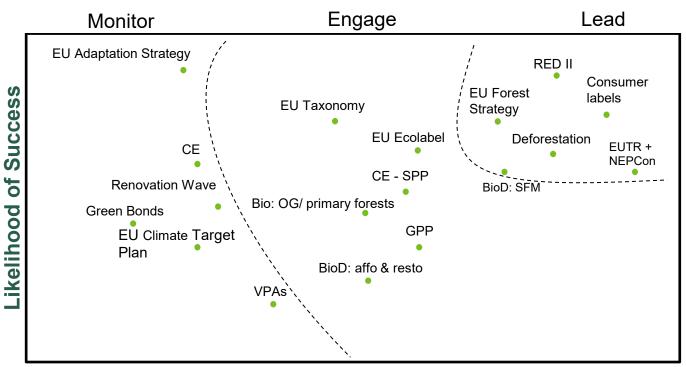

 - Keeping diversity of stakeholder expectations on FSC realistic & measured
- Making reputational gains from FSC's improvements
 - Strengthen credibility across whole value chain through better balance on "FSC system accessibility & integrity"
 - Strengthen FSC's value, position, & relationships with relevant Environmental & Social organisations
- Improve financial diversity & resilience
 - Developing/ testing business model(s) to enable Ecosystem Services to become more financially sustainable
 - Improved coordination and collaboration on external funding opportunities





















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
