FALSK SKOGS CERTIFIERING

- Critical ENGOS were given space in the newspapers
- Critical ENGOs: running campaigns against FSC
- Forest companies reluctant to give positive clear statements about FSC
- The NO worked in a negative atmosphere





Why the FSC critisism?

- The conflict between forestry and environmental groups is pre-dating FSC
- Large proportion of forest owned by large companies or state
- Shortage of timber due to historic felling: harvesting in areas of old forests
- Freedom with responsibility: authorities do not control the legislation. Environmental NGOs critic on FSC is a call more state control
- 50 % of forest area certified

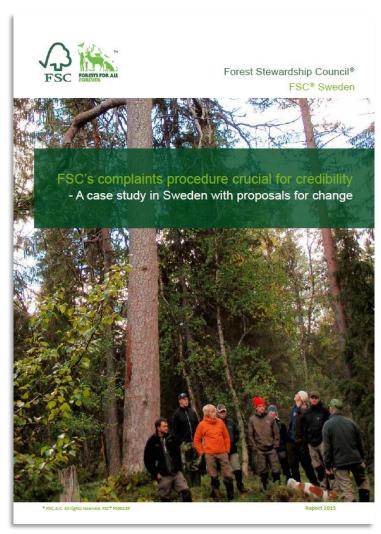

National program for a stronger FSC

- 1. Clearer forest management rules:
 - standard revision
 - develop stakeholder engagement
- 2. Increased openness and improved function of complaints
 - One person supporting complainers
 - Meeting and listening to our critics



National program for a stronger FSC

- 3. Increased knowledge and engagement for FSC
 - Cooperate with members
 - Responding to criticism
- 4. FSC has impact
 - FSC impact on biodiversity
- 5. Rules shall be followed
 - CB calibration
 - Cooperation ASI and FSC international





The tide is turning

- Criticism more precise less general negative criticism
- NO and/or members respond debate articles
- The support to stakeholder for complaints is permanent
- Not letting the critics define FSC
