






General information about the SWSFE:

- 1 of the 6 state forestry enterprises in BG
- 40 units (4 FSC-certified, 36 in certification)
- Area of state-owned forests 680 000 ha (71%)
- FSC-certified area by 09.2019 140 000 ha
- Total forest volume 110 000 000 m³
- Ratio of annual cut vs. forest increment 69%
- Annual cut 1 000 000 m³









Main issues of public interest:

- Illegal logging
- Logging in water protection areas
- "Overharvesting" of forest wood resources
- Damage of forest roads used for tourism
- Export of unprocessed wood in huge quantities
- Garbage in forests





FSC-certification in Bulgaria:

- Key players: WWF-IKEA-MONDI, top forestry scientists and experts, providing assistance for FSC-certification by education and HCVF mapping
- Certified FMUs: mainly state-owned FMUs,
 incl. one private and one municipal FMUs







FSC-certification in Bulgaria:


- Forestry Act (2011)
 (purpose of FSC; requirements for COC; N2000 regimes = FSC)
- Strategy for the forestry sector in BG 2014-2023
 (Aim 50% certified; 200 contractors certified; 160 wood processing units certified)
- 3rd Action plan on climate change 2013-2020


 (Aim Group FSC-certification of 2 159 000 ha by 2020 optionally SWSFE)















Real benefits of FSC-certification in Bulgaria nobody knows about:

- Old-growth forest protection (10% of all state forests)
- Improved forest management and less illegal logging (all FMUs)
- Less garbage in forests (FMU Dospat)
- Increased accessibility of forest roads (FMU Yakoruda)
- **Better safety equipment** (FMU Trigrad)
- Improved communication with stakeholders (Plovdiv group)








Public opinion on FSC – lack of knowledge!

Forest administrators' perception of FSC:

- + Prestige
- Green lucrative scheme (no real independent control)
- Too much bureaucracy
- Certification imposed by law (e.g. COC)
- No real market for FSC-products (see graphic)
- No premium on wood price











What has been done to improve and popularize the role of FSC to Bulgarian public forests:


- Promotion and education on FSC by WWF and forest scientists
- FSC-Fridays organized by WWF (incl. the Forestry Agency)
- Including forest certification in key legal documents
- **Encouraging the participation of local stakeholders**
- Press-releases on the results of FSC-audits (state enterprises)
- NGOs requiring more active role by ASI





Proposals for enhancing the value of FSC for public forests:

- Regular **education** of the forest administrators
- Popularizing the role of FSC for **solving local issues** (incl. the role of stakeholders during audits)
- Promoting the documented benefits of FSC for tourism, nature-protection, climate change
- Public registers/databases with information about the documented benefits of FSC
- Make clear how FSC makes difference (sustainable forestry vs. Amazon clear-cuts)
- At least 30% participation of international auditors during audits
- More active role of ASI as independent control body
- Transparency of FSC-processes for the general public (e.g. on-line HCVF maps such as on http://gori.uzdp.bg/en, press-releases and on-line information about the on-going audits, etc.)
