

- » 4 visits to members






# Finance Management

#### Main issues:

- » Stable financial situation:
  - » budget adopted 1 year in advance, whereas the financing framework and membership fees are calculated for 3-year periods
  - » stabilization of buffer to ensure cash flow is much higher than the minimum required
- » Membership fees 2018:
  - » Duly paid except from Bosnia i Herzegovina, Saxony-Anhalt and Lithuania
  - » Slovak Fee 2017 still unresolved
- » HOUSE Cash Report for info only; figures included in the Annual Financial Report by Deloitte
- » Depreciation not reflected in cash report (direct expense) important to keep in mind when comparing Deloitte figures with cash reports


